

# **Engaging Next-Generation Leaders in Information about Service and Training (ENLIST) Act**

*This bill requires high schools to prominently display military recruiting information so students can fully consider service as a path after graduation.*

## **Key Legislative Provisions**

- Requires secondary schools to display and make accessible information regarding military recruiting during school hours.
- Builds on existing law that guarantees military recruiters have the same access to schools as colleges and employers.

## **Background**

- Federal law mandates access for military recruiters in schools receiving federal funds, but many schools fall short in making recruitment information visible and accessible to students outside of recruiter visits.
- College brochures and career fair flyers line the walls—this bill ensures military service information gets equal space.
- By requiring recruiting materials to be available, this bill empowers students with full knowledge of all post-graduation pathways, including the opportunity to serve.
